## Title IX



As defined: Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972 prohibits any person in the United States from being discriminated against on the basis of sex, including sexual harassment, in seeking access to any educational program or activity receiving federal financial assistance


- Title IX Coordinator role within BCPS
  - Department of School Safety
  - Awareness
- Scope of Title IX
  - Deny educational access
  - Occur in context BCPS exercises substantial control over


- Notification of allegations
  - Response to allegations
  - Supportive measures
    - Counseling/Social Work Services/Community Mental Health Partnership/EAP
    - Separation
    - Schedule change
- Grievance Process
  - Student
  - Staff

#### Data for the 2023-2024 School Year





As of April 17, 2024, 96 referrals received. One referral has been initiated through the Title IX process.

First identified is the complainant, second is the respondent. 25 complaints occurred off campus.
