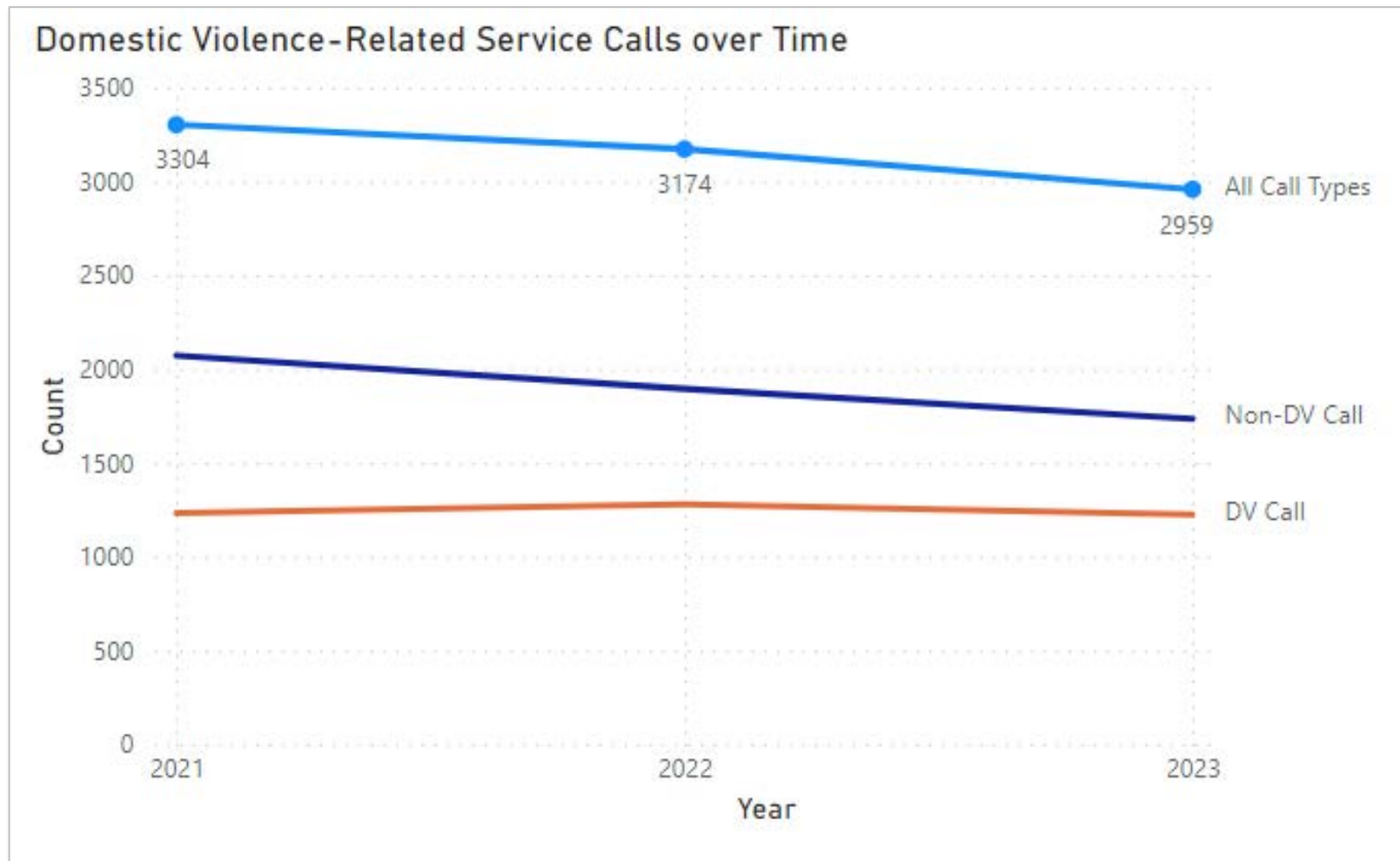

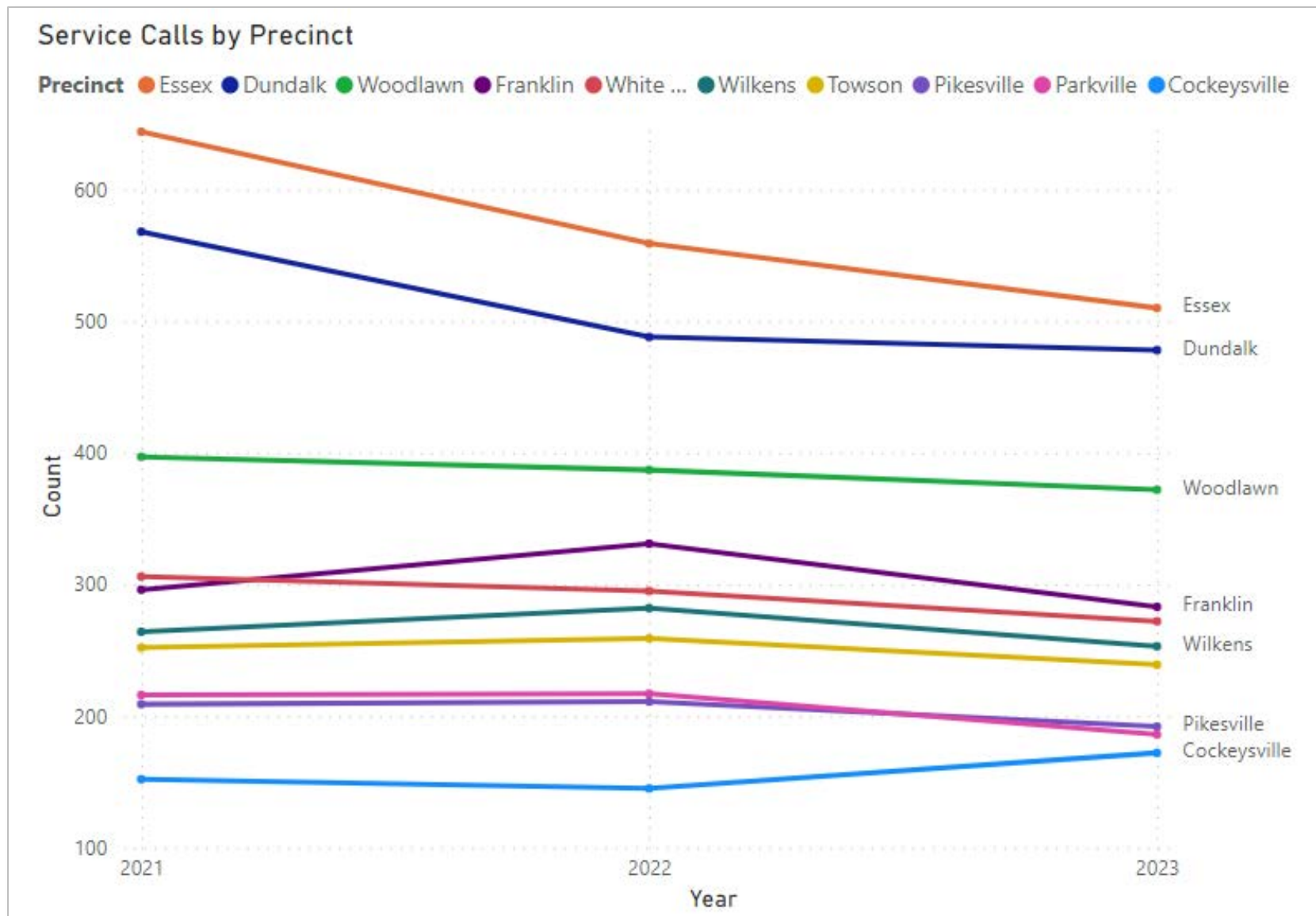
DV-Related Calls for Service



Service Call	2021 – 2022	2022 – 2023
All Types	-3.9%	-6.7%
Non-DV Call	-8.5%	-8.4%
DV Call	+3.8%	-4.3%

Call types not included here may also contain some other or less specific Domestic Involvement such as Verbal Domestic Disturbance or simply Domestic Disturbance

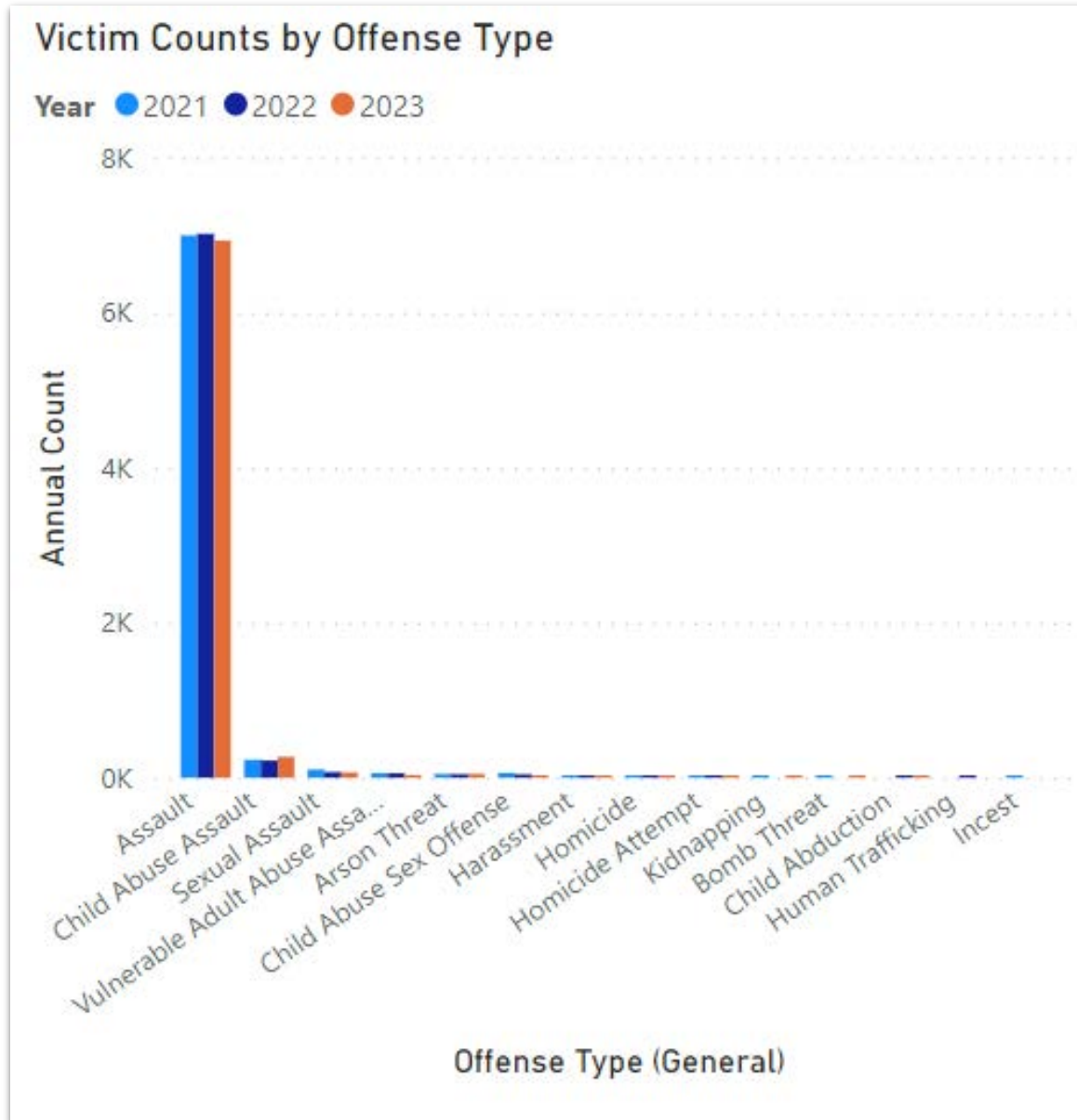
Overview Count

Victims and Arrestees

- Number of Domestic Violence Victims has been decreasing slightly year over year for the last 2 years.
- Number of Arrestees related to Domestic Violence increased in 2022 and decreased in 2023.

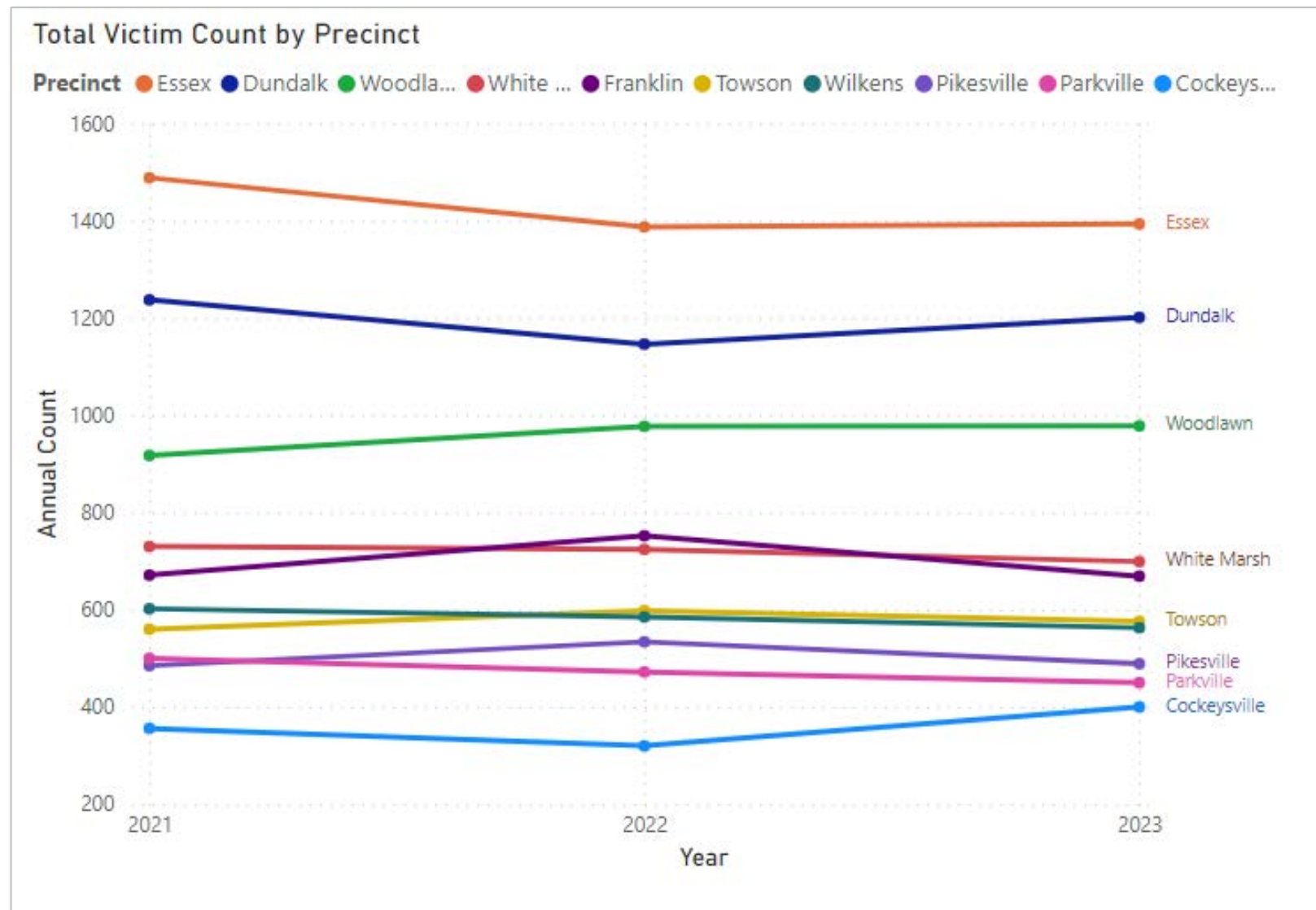


- About 93% of DV victim cases each year are assault offenses.
- About 3% of DV victim cases each year are child abuse assault offenses.

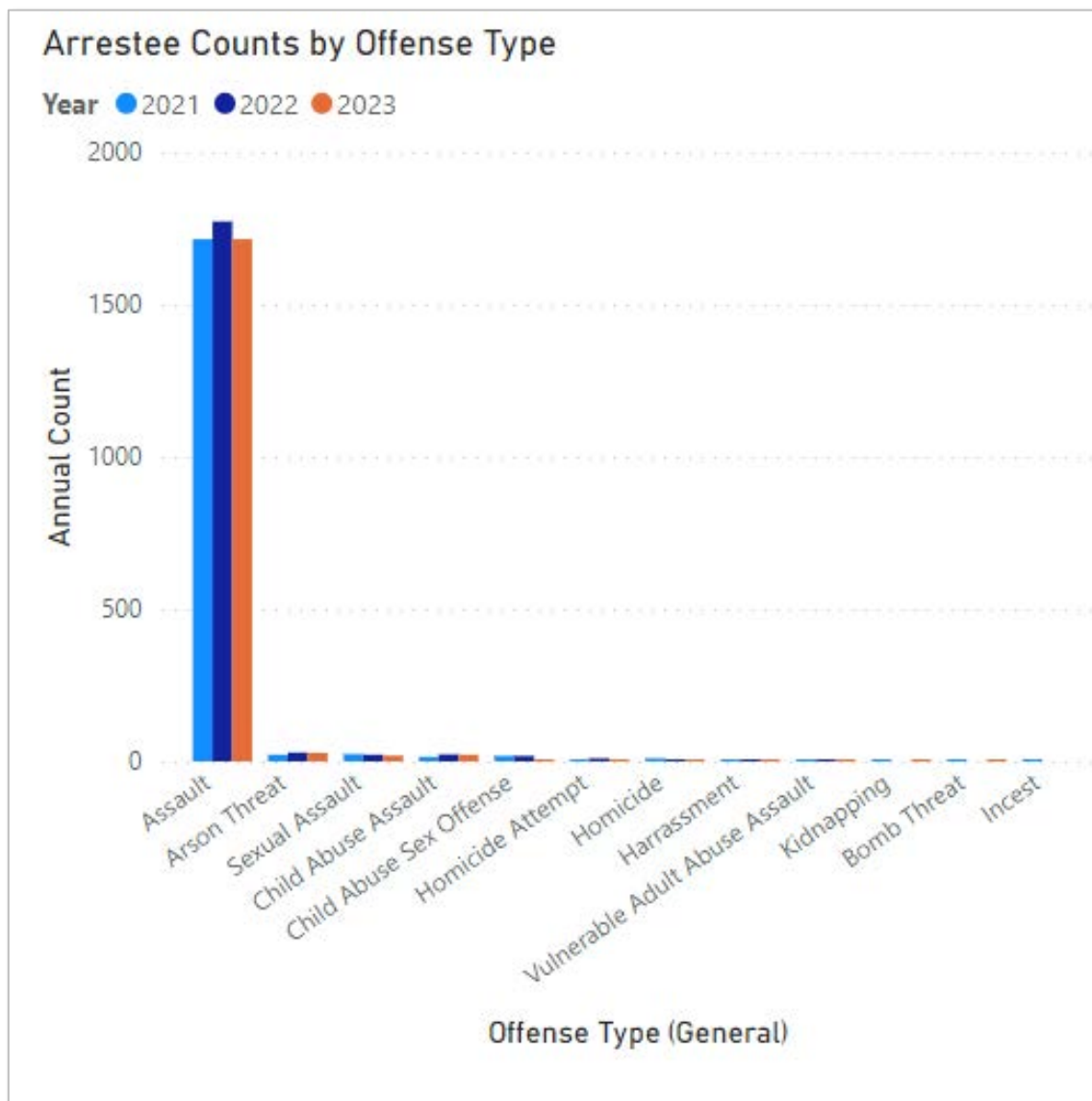

Arrestee Case Counts

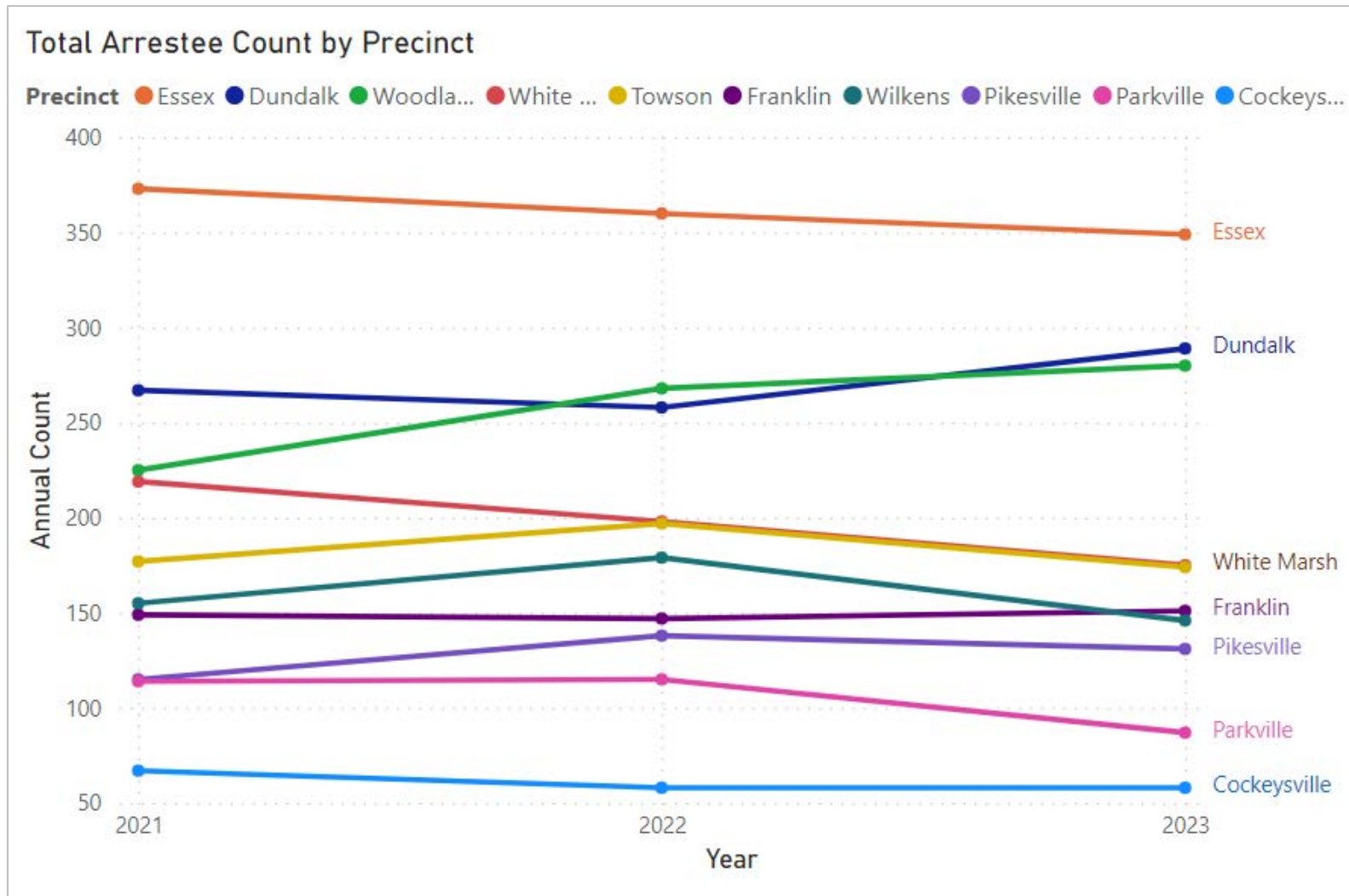


- About 94% of DV arrestee cases each year are assault offenses.
- About 1% of DV arrestee cases each year are arson threat offenses.

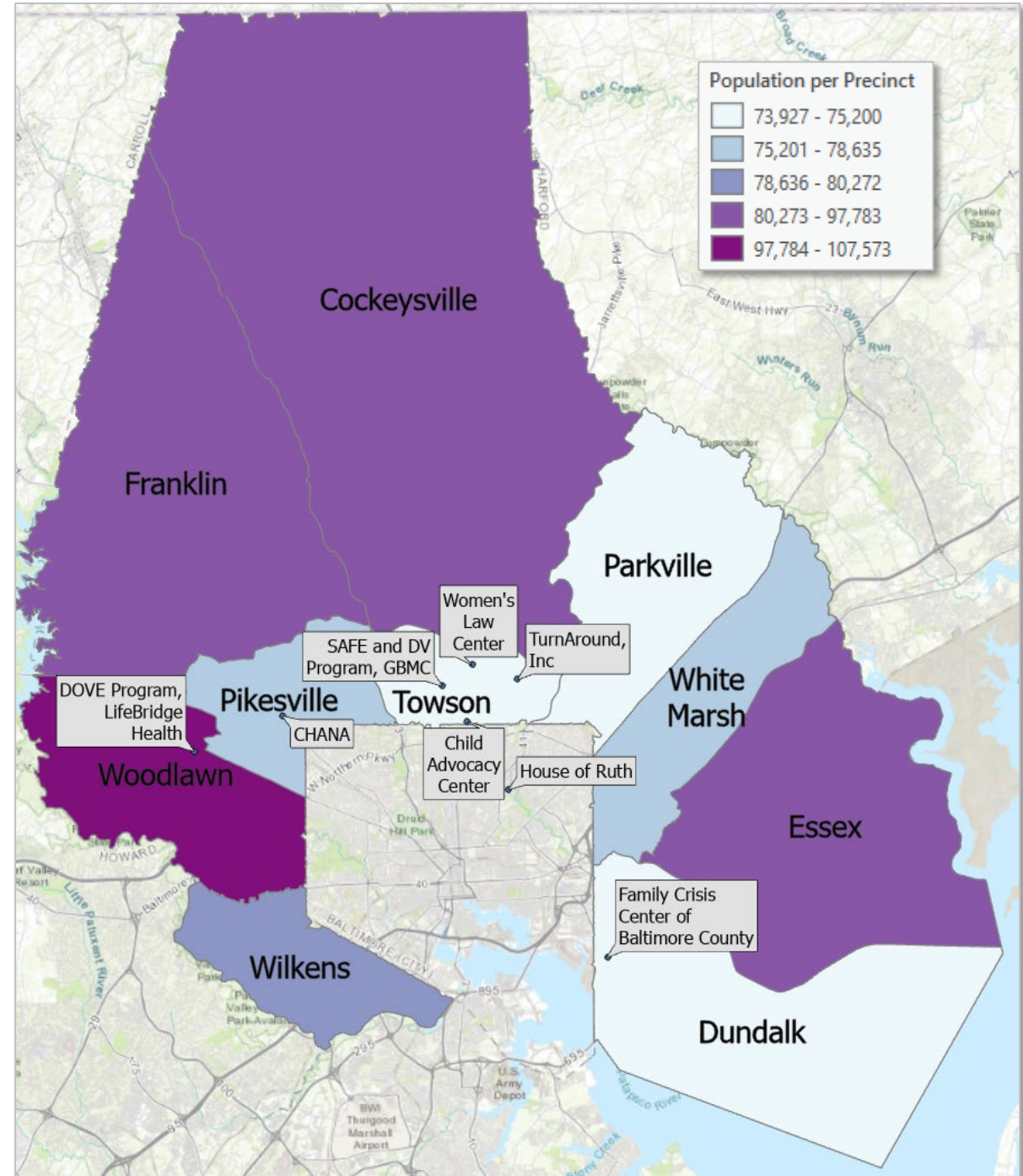

Parkville is the least populated precinct at about 74K residents and Woodlawn is the most populated at about 107K residents.



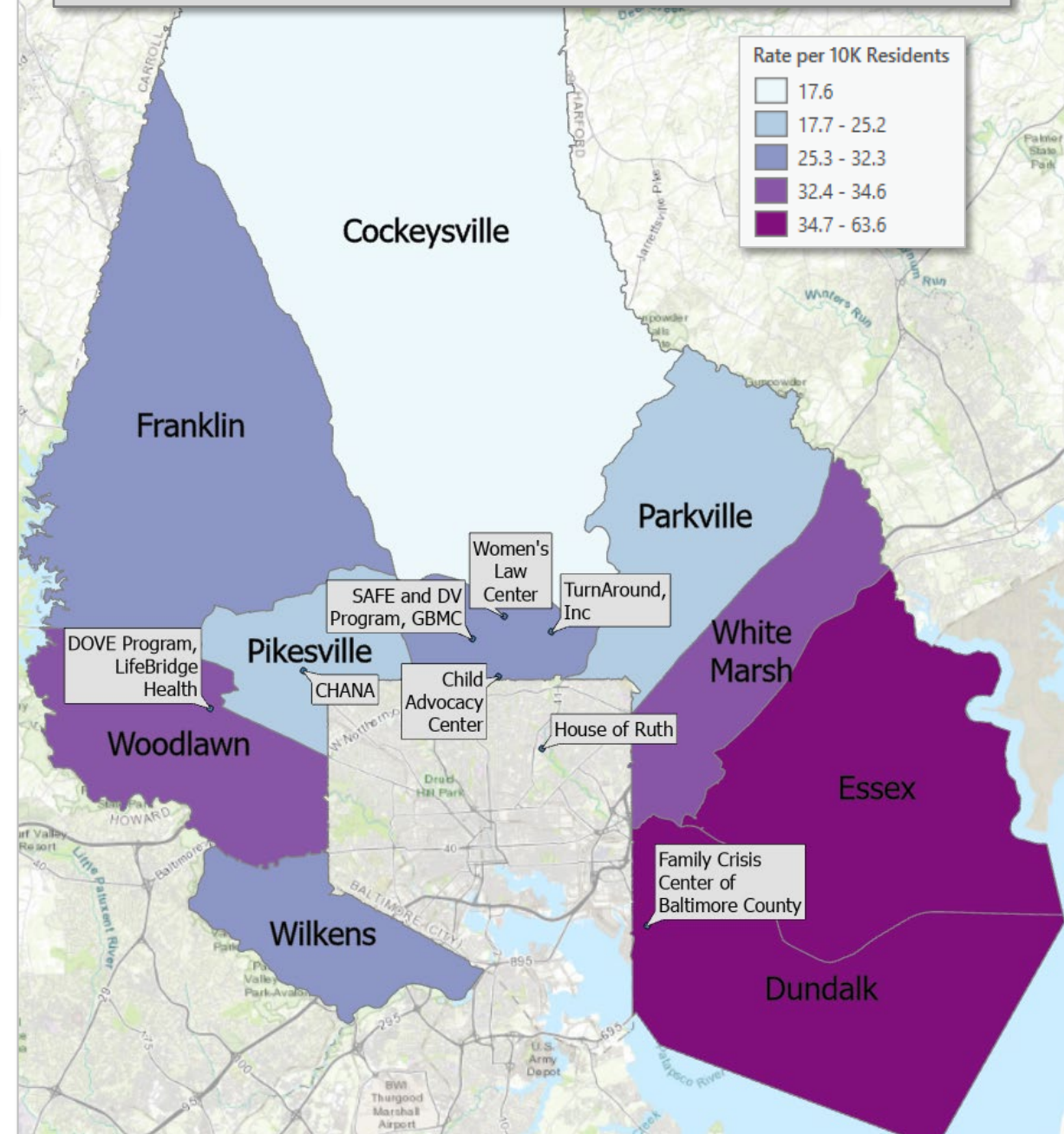
Service Calls

By Precinct, per 10K Residents

For 2023, Dundalk has the highest rate of DV-related service calls at about 63.6 calls per 10,000 residents.

Rate of DV-Related Calls per Precinct for 2023

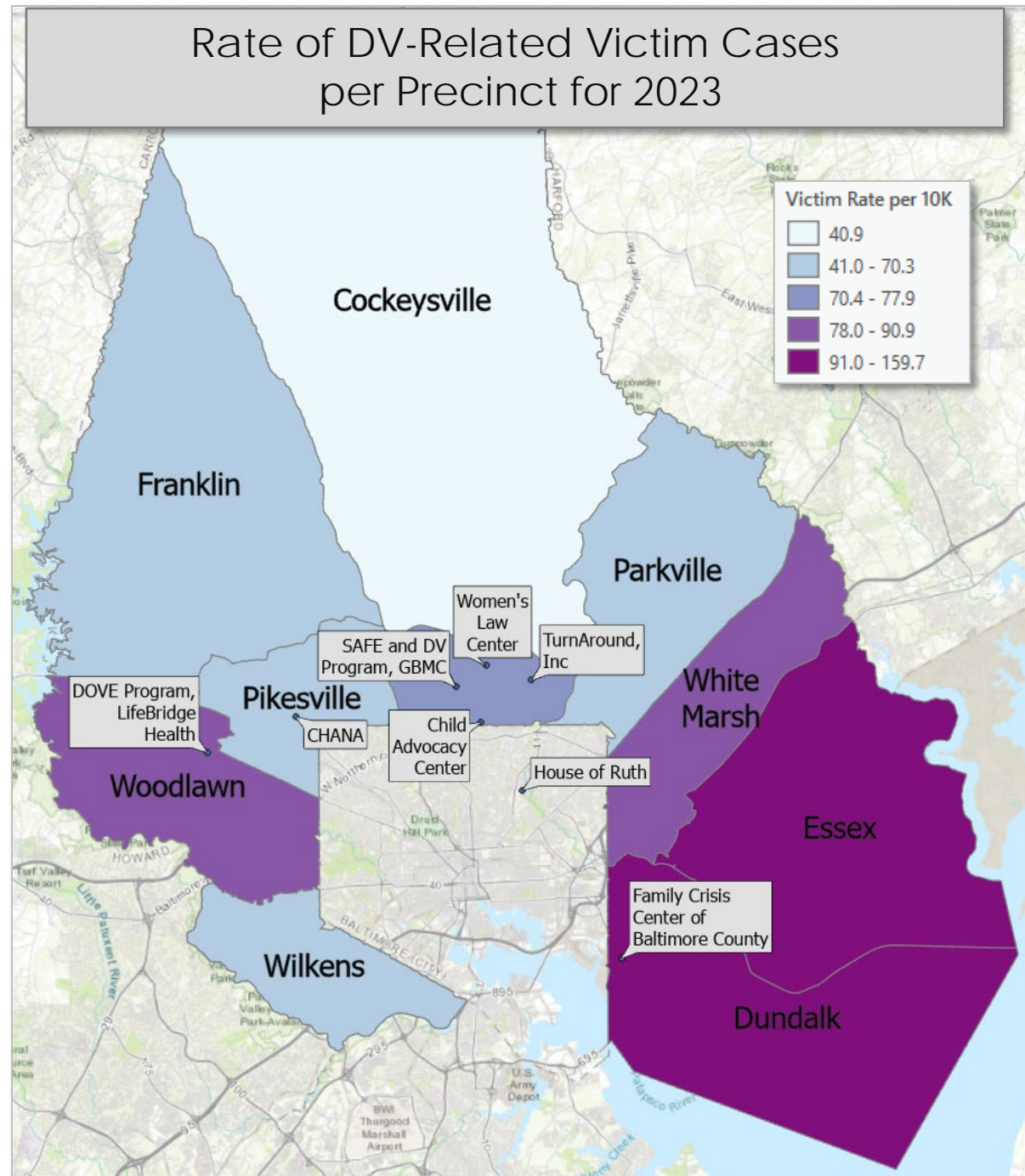


Victim Case Count

For 2023, Dundalk has the highest rate of DV Victim case counts at about 159.7 cases per 10,000 residents.

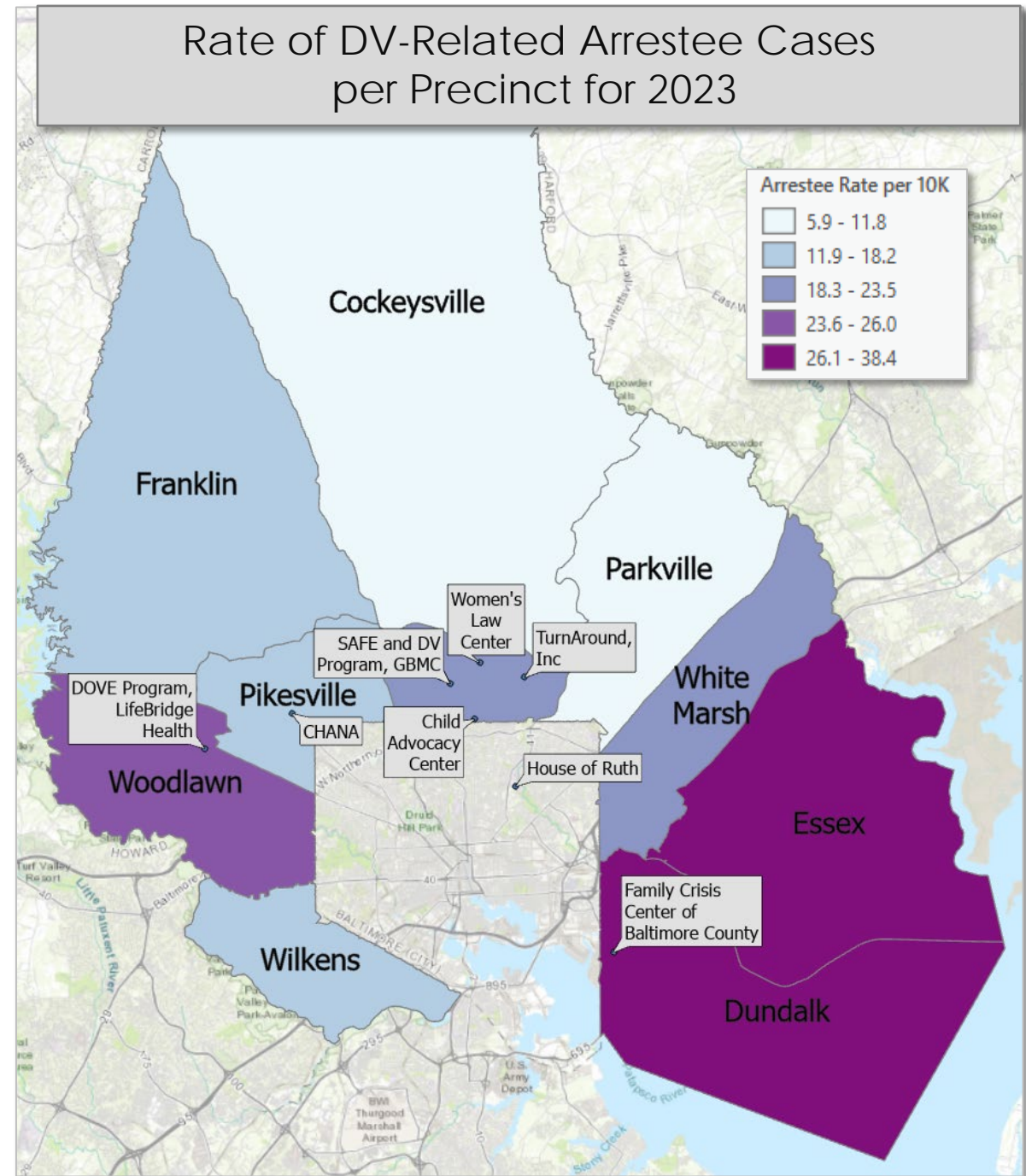


Arrestee Case Count

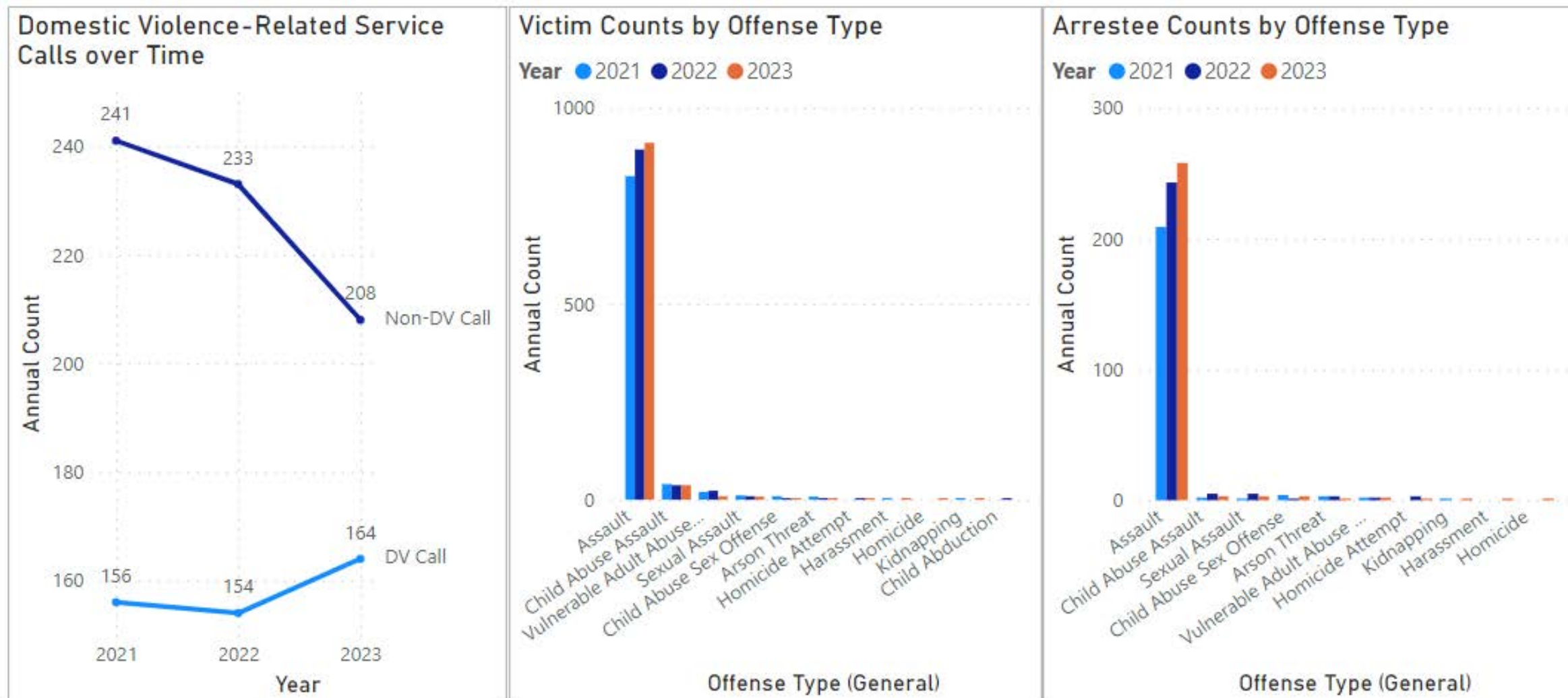

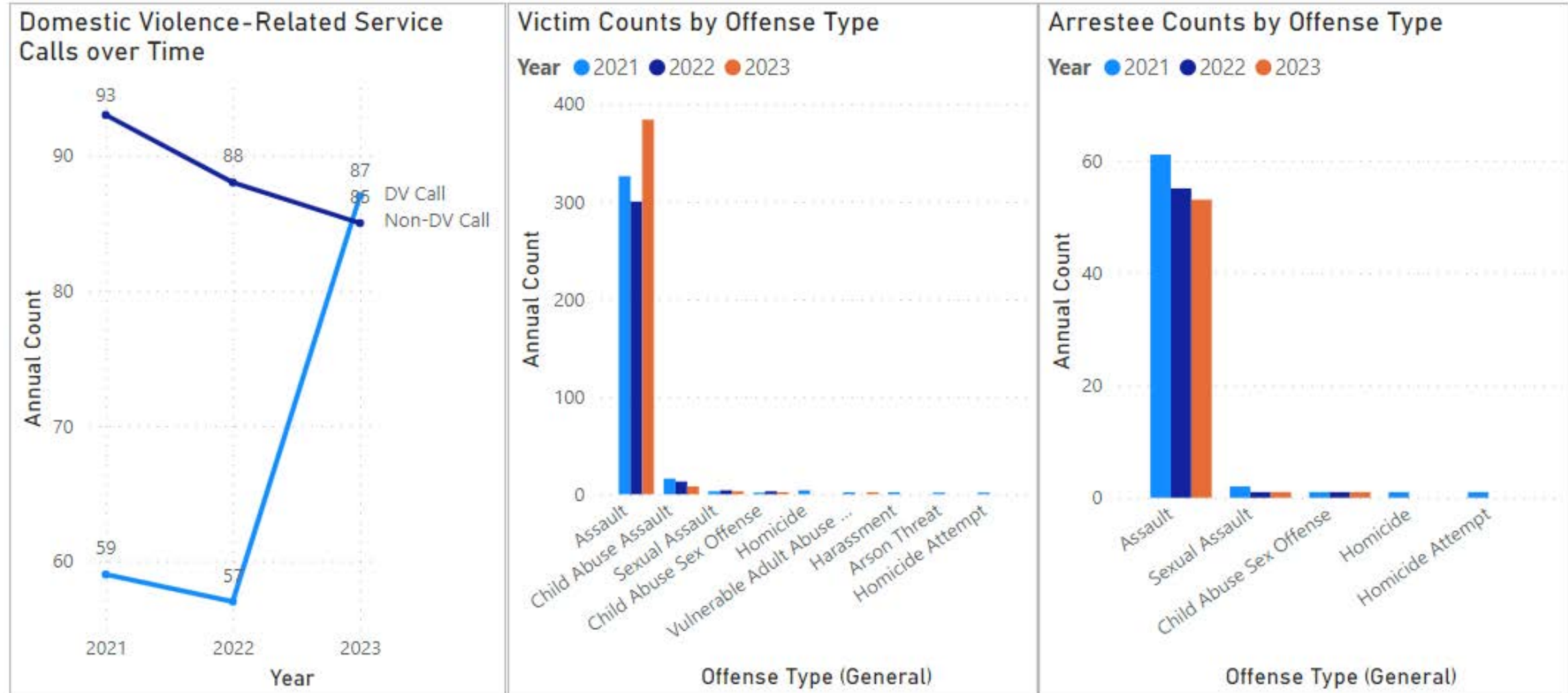

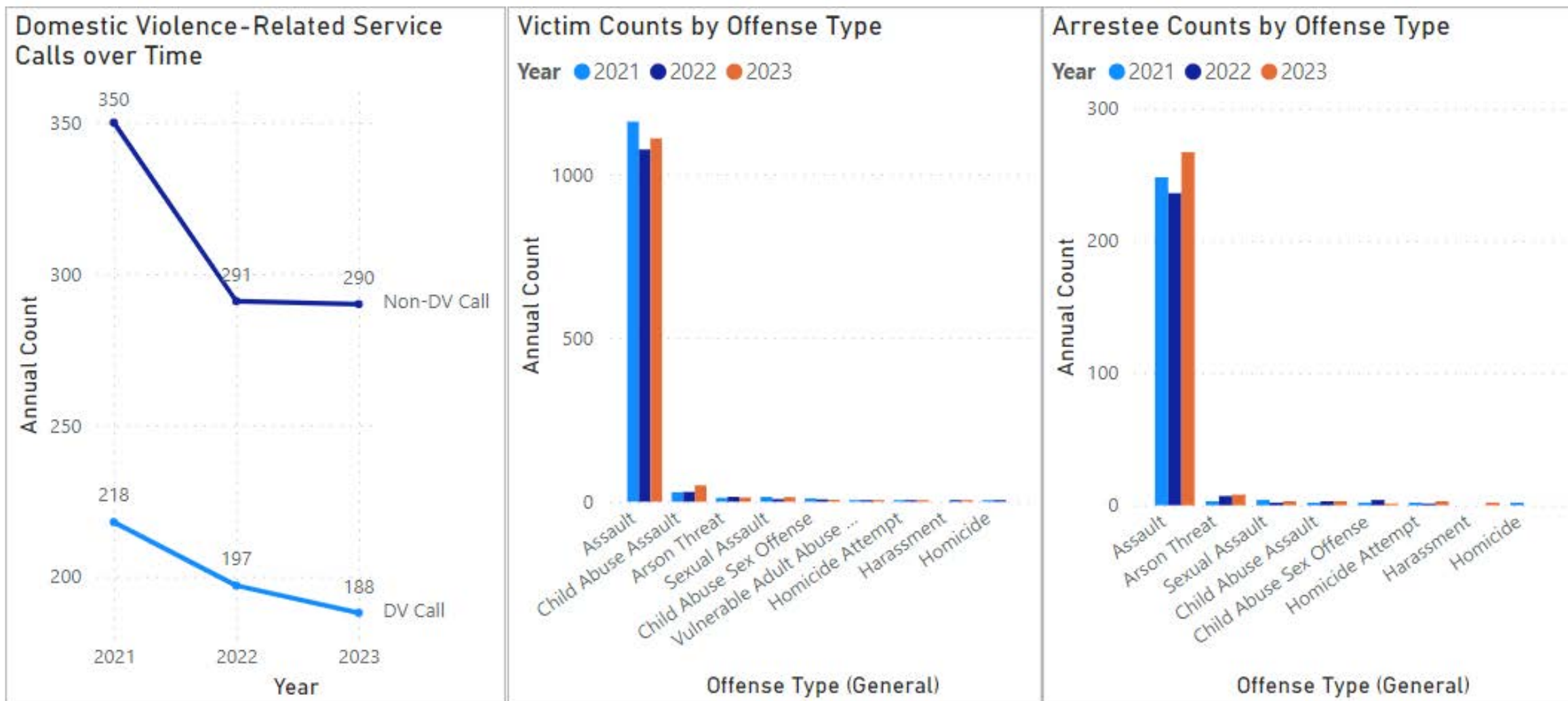
